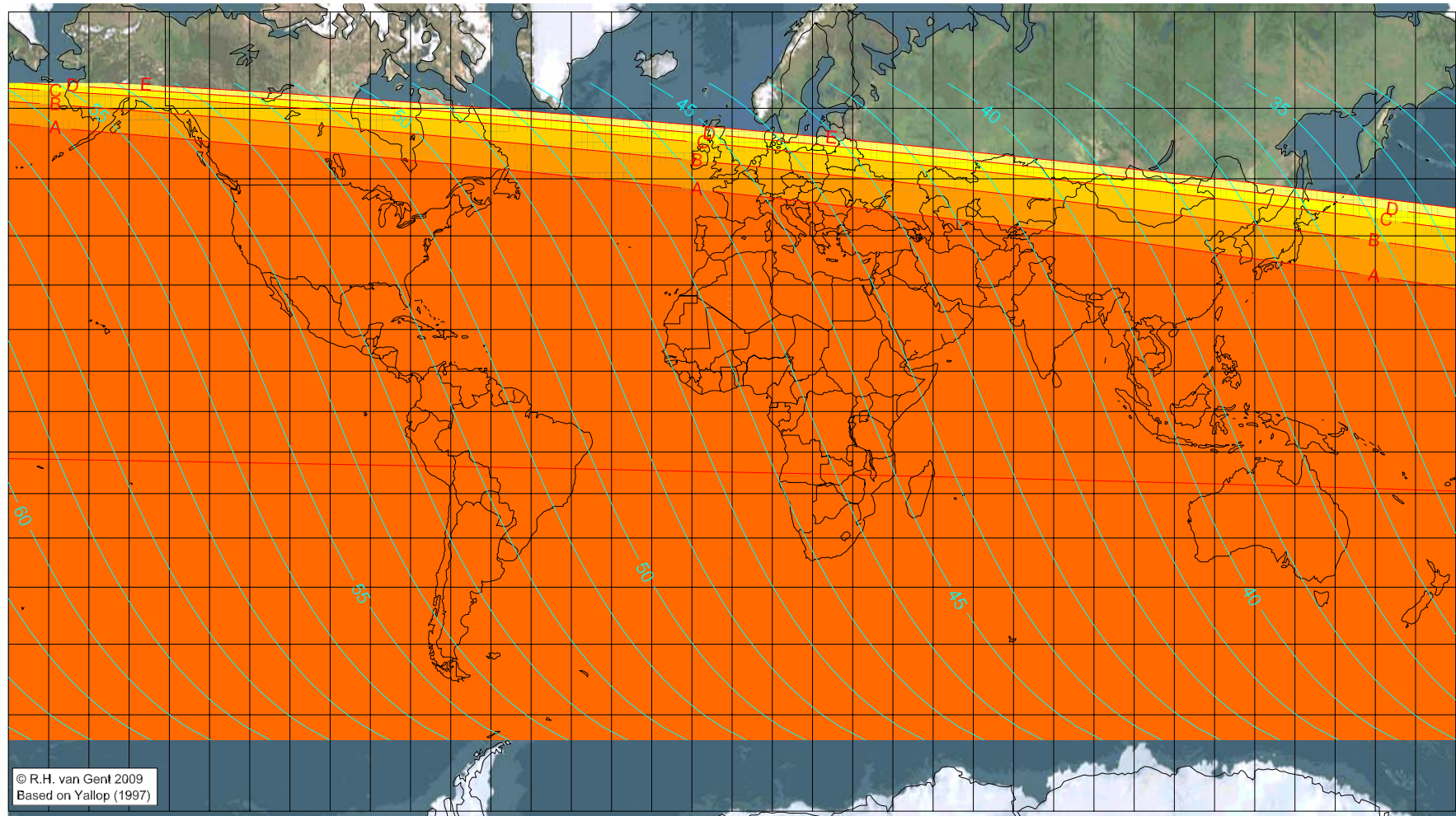


First visibility lunar crescent for Dhū 'l-Hijja 1430 AH

Lunar age (in hours) is given for the 'best time', defined as the moment 4/9ths between sunset and moonset
