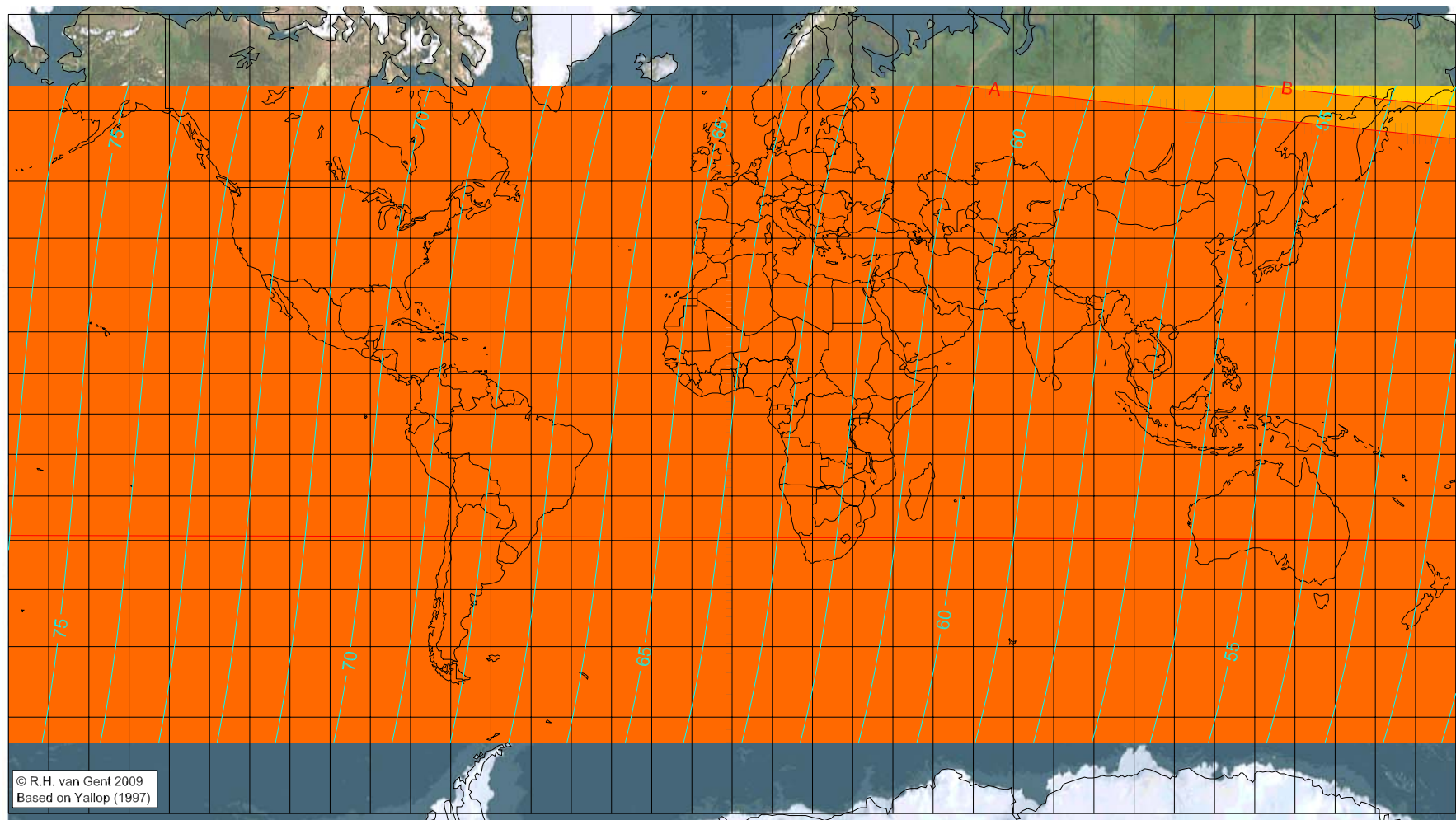


First visibility lunar crescent for Ramaḍān 1431 AH

Lunar age (in hours) is given for the 'best time',
defined as the moment 4/9ths between sunset
and moonset
