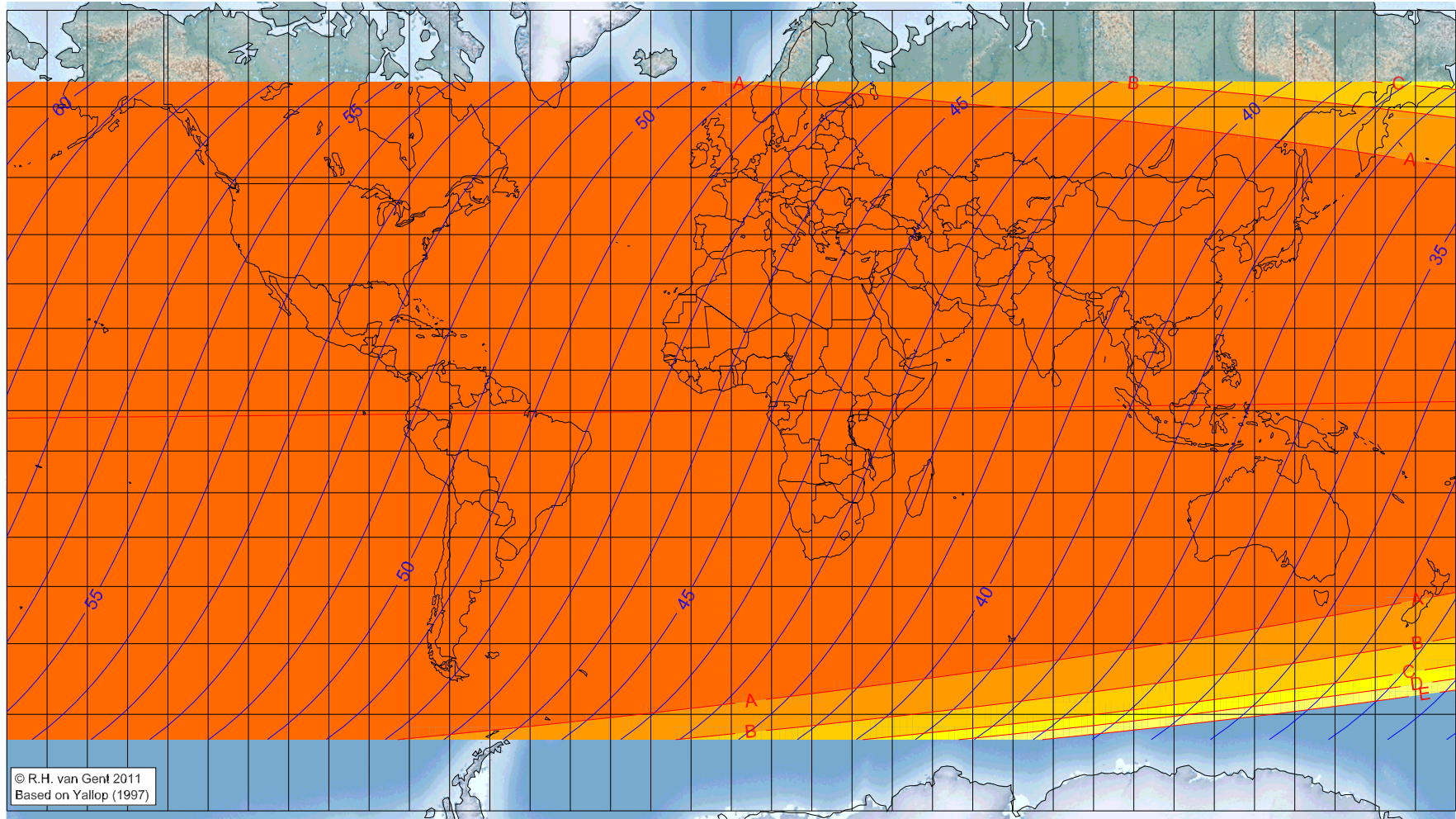


First visibility lunar crescent for Rajab 1432 AH

Second day after luni-solar conjunction



Astronomical New Moon: 1 June 2011, 21h 2.6m (UTC)

$\Delta T = 1.1$ min

Astronomical (Brown) Lunation Number = 1094

Islamic Lunation Number = 17179

- A – easily visible to the unaided eye
- B – visible under perfect atmospheric conditions
- C – may need optical aid before visible to the unaided eye
- D – only visible with binoculars or a telescope
- E – Danjon limit (8°) – invisible even with optical aid

Lunar age (in hours) is given for the 'best time', defined as the moment 4/9ths between sunset and moonset
