


# First visibility lunar crescent for Rabī' al-Ākhir 1437 AH

Day of luni-solar conjunction



Astronomical New Moon: 10 January 2016, 1h 30.6m (UTC)

- █ A – easily visible to the unaided eye
- █ B – visible under perfect atmospheric conditions
- █ C – visible to the unaided eye after found with optical aid
- █ D – only visible with binoculars or conventional telescopes
- █ E – not visible with conventional telescopes
- █ F – below Danjon limit ( $7^\circ$ )
