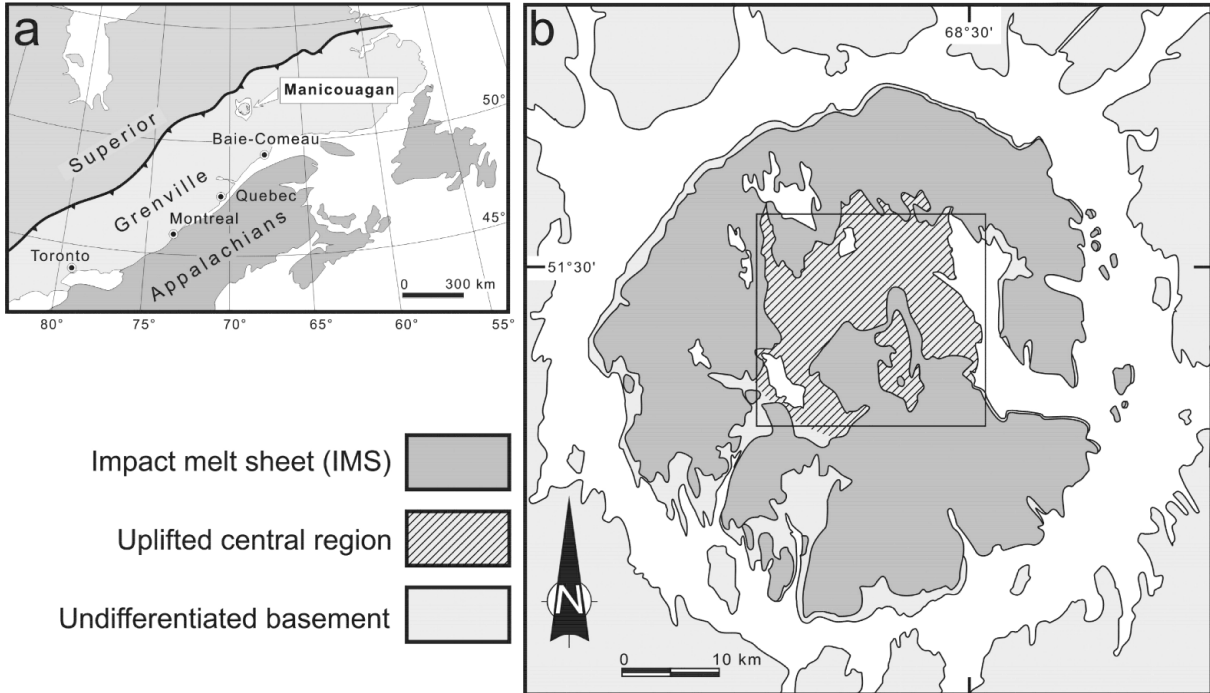


MANICOUAGAN MELT MAP

The map shows that when kayaking the circuit one meets impact melt only at the Eastern shores of island René Levasseur. In our 2006 circuit my wife and I found beautiful glacier-polished stretches of it on the small islands at two o'clock (taking the island as a clock dial).
